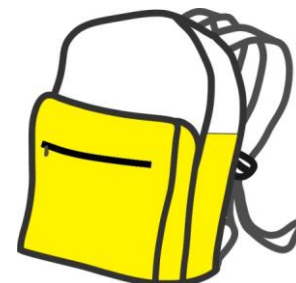


COMMUNITY IMMUNITY HONORABLE MENTION

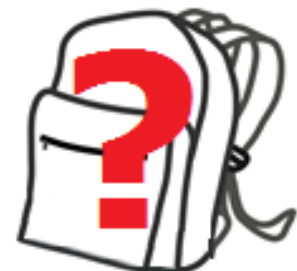


SCHOOLS THAT DID NOT REPORT
