(41% more than 2014)

11,277 individuals vaccinated, including school staff

Shoo the Flu is a program to provide free in-school flu vaccinations for Oakland area preschool and elementary students with parent consent.

138 Schools Participated

(25% more than 2014)

180 were invited to participate

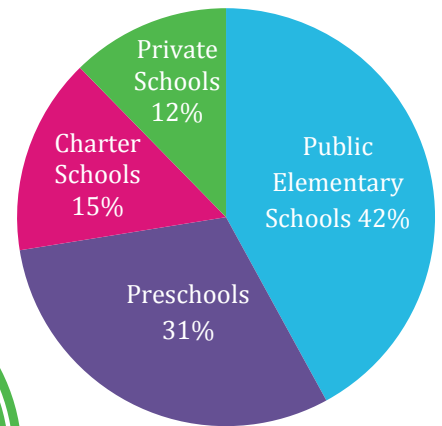

52% of vaccines administered were for uninsured/ low income students

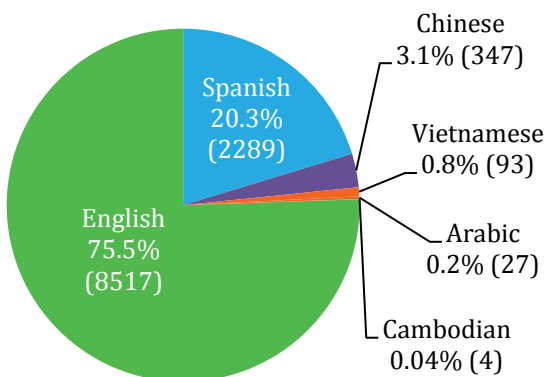
Schools averaged a 28% participation rate
