Everyone 6 months and older is recommended to receive a yearly flu

- The below options are available for the following Alameda County residents:
- Low Income Children (birth to 19 years old) who:**
- Are uninsured
 - Are eligible for or enrolled in CHDP/Medi-Cal
 - Are American Indian/Alaskan native
- Low Income Adults who:**
- Have no health insurance or whose insurance does not cover immunizations
- No one** will be turned away for inability to pay for the vaccine or give a donation
