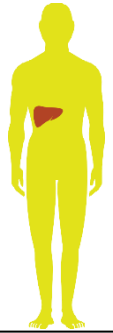




# Alameda County Hepatitis A Immunization Clinics

These clinics will be distributing **Hepatitis A Vaccine only**  
 Updated 2/15/2018



**Everyone who is at risk of getting Hepatitis A is recommended to receive a Hepatitis A shot** (Persons currently experiencing homelessness, Persons using illicit drugs, Men who have sex with men, etc)

- The very best place to go for all vaccinations is your doctor's office.
- Vaccines are also available at many local and chain pharmacies – call in advance

The below options are available for the following Alameda County residents:

**Low Income Adults (19 years and older) who:**

- Are uninsured
- Are eligible for CHDP/Medi-Cal
- Have no health insurance or whose insurance does not cover immunizations
